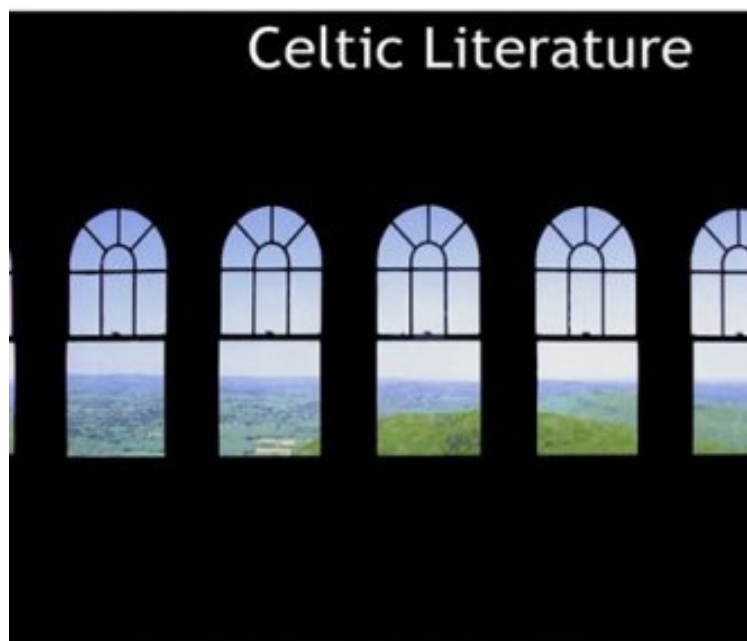

stanzas. The Annals of the Four Masters is another interesting literary conversation piece with a solid foundation in the destruction of churches and castles of old. Here is a sample of the poetry: "For acuteness of valor, the Greeks. For excessive pride, the Romans. For dulness, the creeping Saxons; For beauty and amorousness, the Gaedhils." Overall, this volume is a useful critique on Celtic literature and its origins and interconnectedness to British, Welsh and Irish literature. The Celtic vocabulary is complex to read for newbies to this form of writing.
