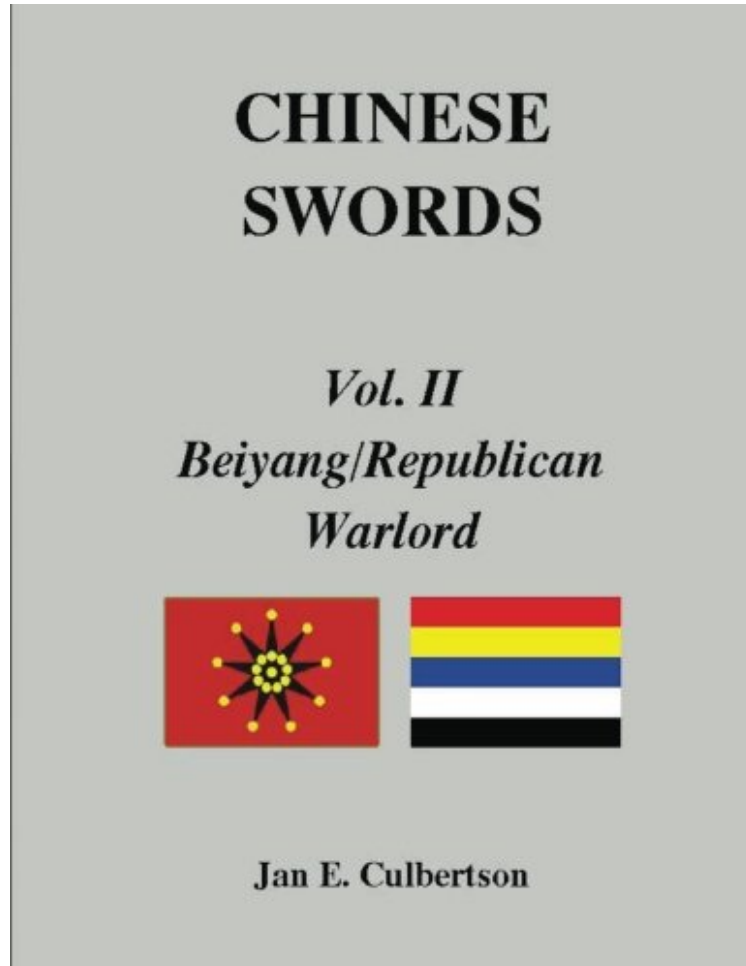

When the pack of books arrived, I was deeply disappointed at the following findings:- Most of the photographs were tiny and badly printed;- Plenty of 'white spaces' on each page: most pages consist of a couple of blurry photos and a little accompanying text;- Lots of descriptive texts printed alongside the photos were done Reverse background, ie. white letters on black background! To make matter worse, these text were misaligned in printing, making them blurry and extremely difficult to read;Good thing allows Refunds which I promptly went for: bought the 3 volumes and refund all 3 of them. Period.
