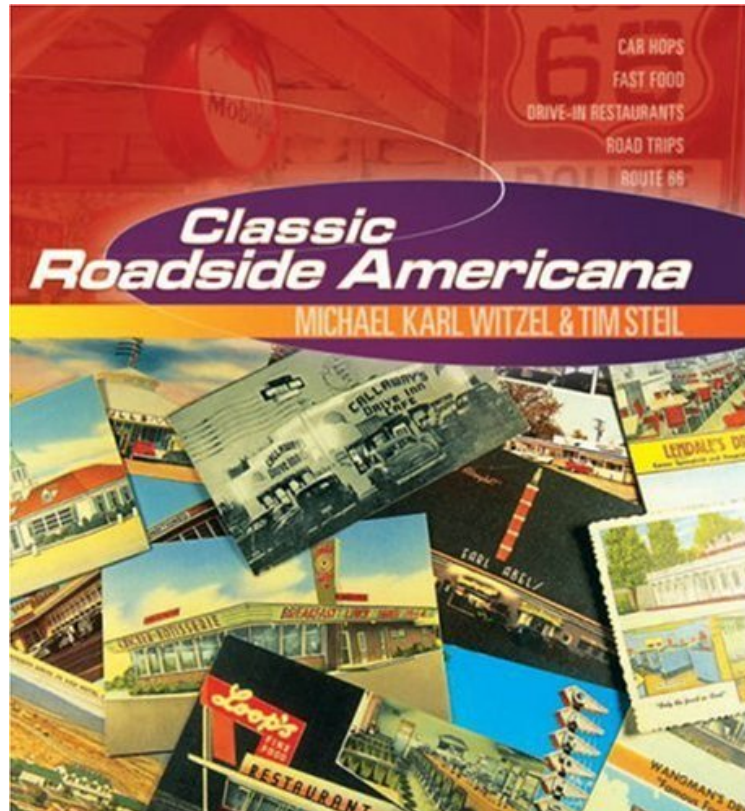

Michael Witzel has been turning out roadside Americana books for years, essentially reforming similar words and images to suit any title. Steil's pages on the Mother Road also tread the same format as many others about Route 66. The fact that you can pick up this title very cheaply is enough of an indication to me that the contents are the usual photos and text, which, of course, they are. There is nothing new here and much better books cover the two subjects.
