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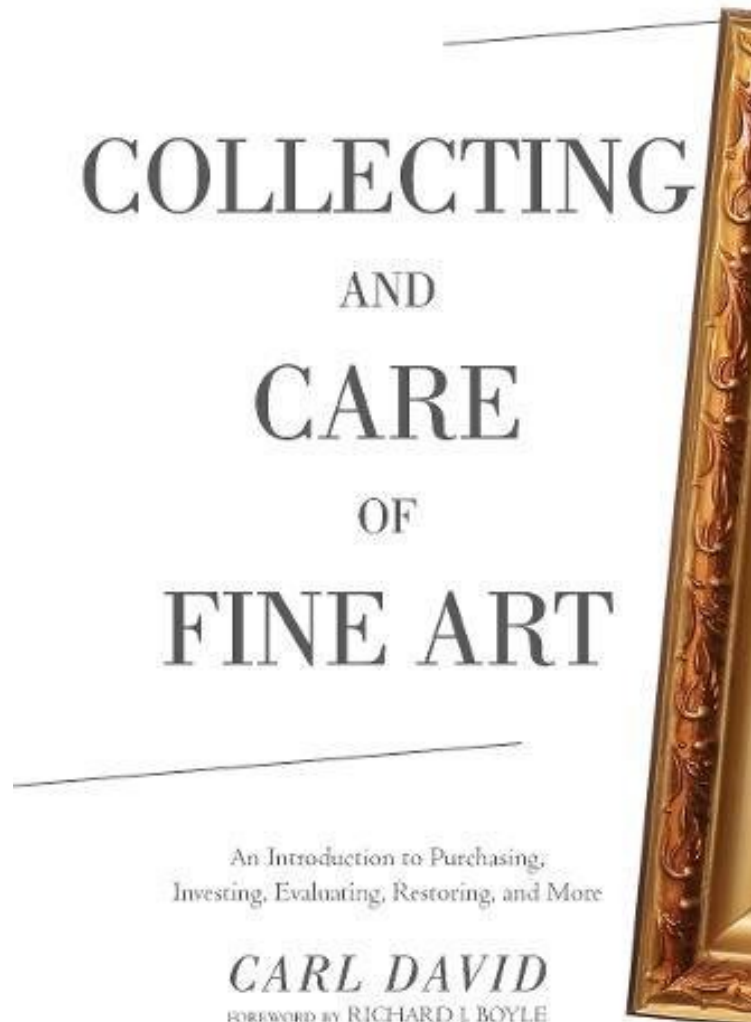

Instead, I was left with more questions than answers after reading this book. In the end, if you are really looking for information on art collecting and more specifically on how to begin collecting, look at other available books that provide more detailed approaches.
