Charts are easy to read. Although all of the threads/yarns used in this book are European, yds per pound (and meters per kilo) are given so that substitutions are easy. The designs are straightforward and can be woven as given, or can be used as a launching off place for many other wonderful household items. Included are dishtowels, blankets, rugs, even lace curtains! There are projects for beginning weavers as well as advanced. It includes napkins, tablecloths, pillows, rugs, upholstery fabric and many many towels. The projects are

mostly linen, but also include cotton and wool, depending on the use for the final project. Most projects use 4 or 8 shafts, though some are plain weave. The yarns do not appear to be commonly available in the US, besides the Bockens Linen.
