

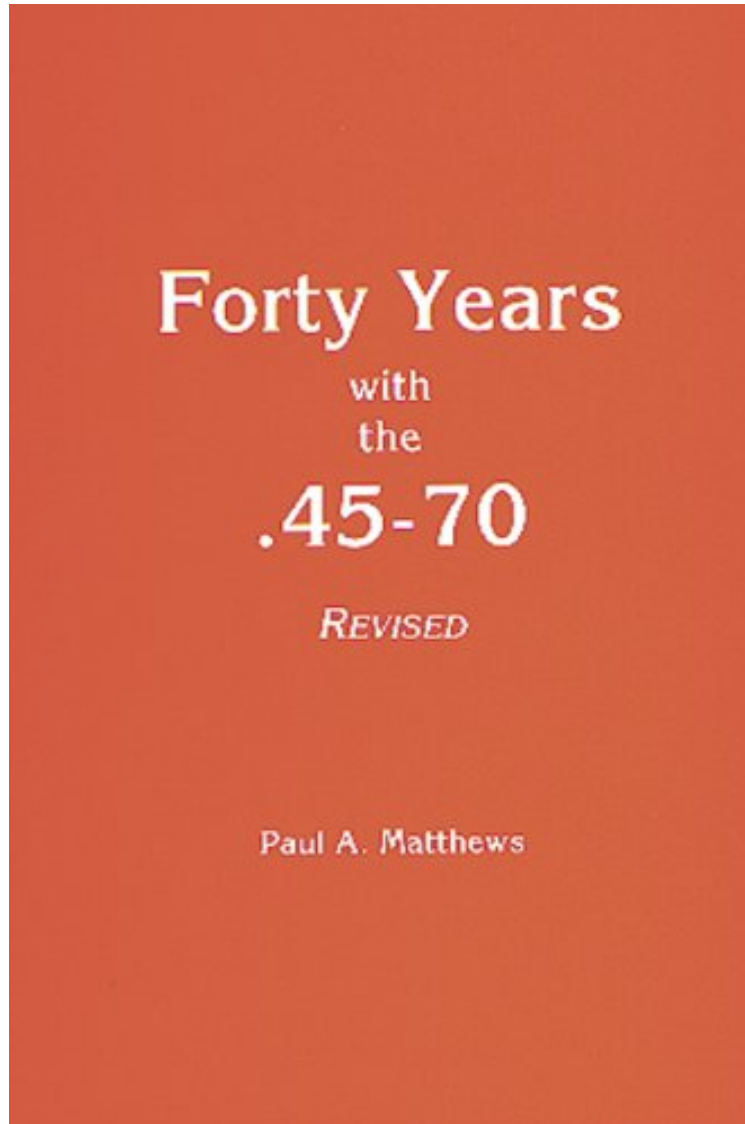

rifle. Matthews did his own casting and reloading for decades with very little information to go by. He was one of the early guys who figured out how powerful a modern .45-70 could be. This book is his learning that a big soft bullet at moderately low speeds hunts great at shorter ranges, without a ton of recoil. A bit faster gives him an edge when the game is walking quickly, and all the power he'll ever need.
