

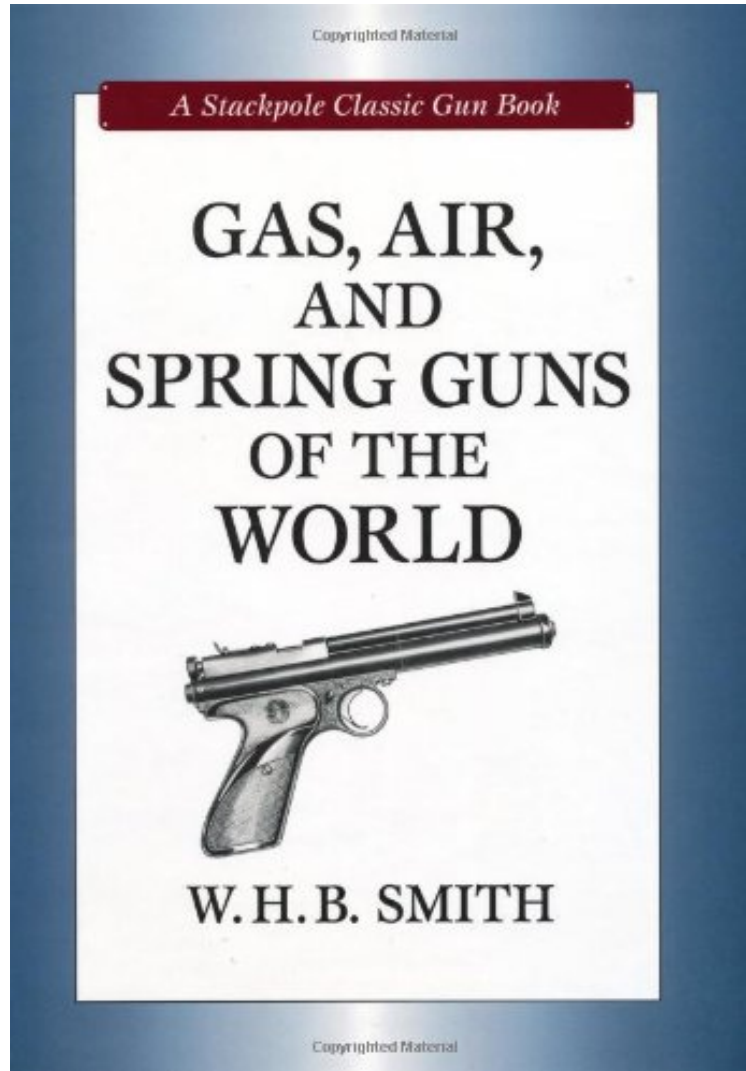

While Smith's writing is a product of its time (particularly evident in the poorly translated section on air guns from a Russian encyclopedia as contrasted to the rest of the work) it is a fun and interesting time capsule from the mid 20th century.
