From Library JournalThis set includes complete, full-sized, color reproductions of 50 elaborate consumer catalogs published between 1902 and 1954 by one of the world's most influential toy firms. It is an impressive publication, with copies of some amazingly scarce early catalogs. Of the nearly 1800 pages in the four volumes, about three-quarters are excellent reproductions of half-tone color illustrations. These are the best reproductions of old Lionel catalogs available, and the only ones sold as hardbound books rather than separate pamphlets. Unlike collectors' guides, they will not go out of date. And they will appeal to a wide variety of readers, including serious Lionel train collectors, people interested in the history of American merchandising, and those with just a nostalgic interest in old toys. Before ordering, libraries should check to see whether they already own volumes 1 and 2 of Greenberg's Lionel Catalogs (Greenberg Pub. Co., 1982), which are identical to volumes 3 and 4 of this set.
