The Collector's Friend By Michael A Dorosh I am the author of CANUCK, planned as a companion series to the SOLDAT series; having said that up front, I would like to champion Cyrus' books on German military equipment. His series does a lot of things no other series has yet done; provide detail rich current photos of actual equipment and how it was worn, with detailed information on variants, insights into the soldiers' lives, and some very good comments on telling original items from postwars or reproductions - a must for serious collectors. These books are a great alternative to pricier, and out of print, works like Angolia's much more comprehensive books. For the collector, Lee's books are probably even a little better as the photos are larger and clearer.

Soldat is designed as a handbook for the collector of German Army combat uniforms, equipment and weapons. The detailed photos provide the military modeler with needed exacting details. 5" 1/2x8 1/2", 196 pages, 124 photos, 12 color pages, paperback
