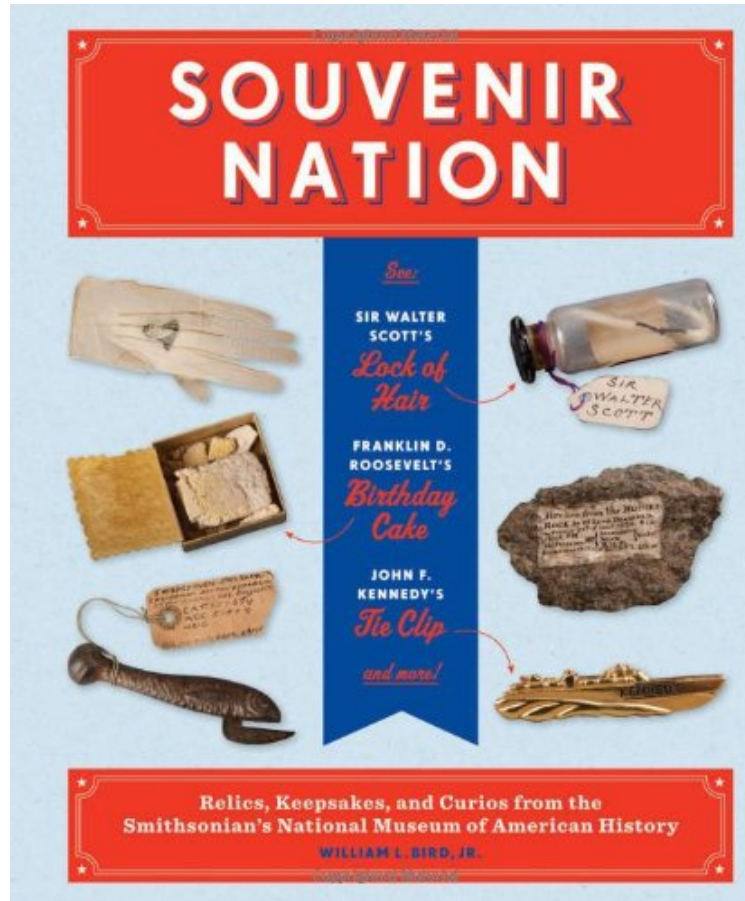


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Souvenir Nation: Relics, Keepsakes, and Curios from the Smithsonian's National Museum of American History
