

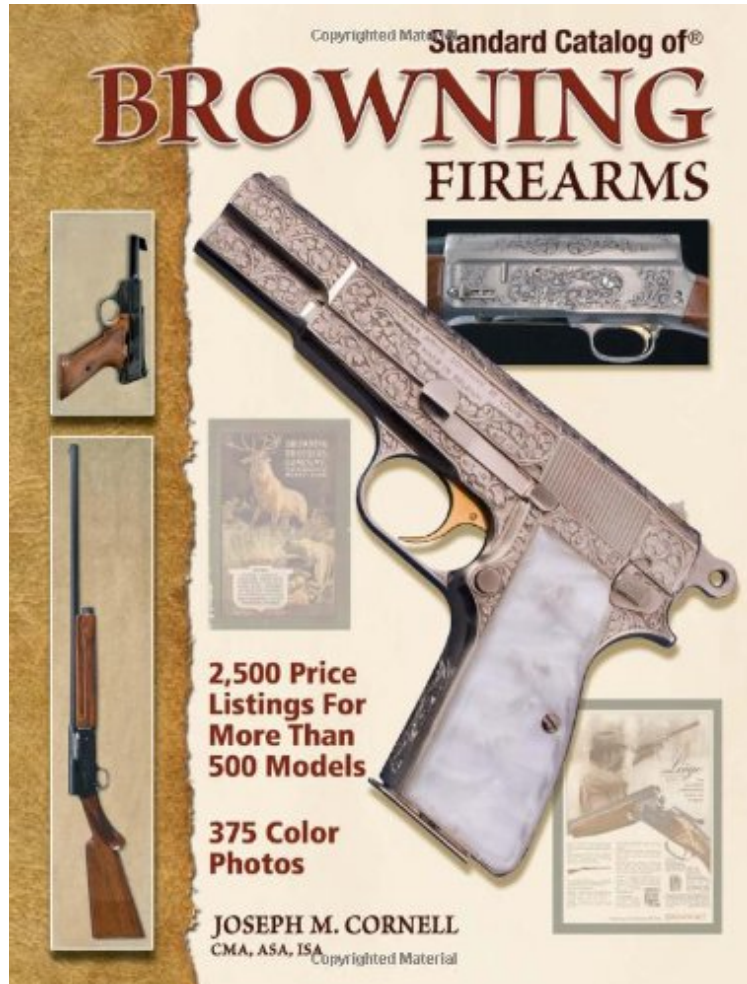

This book does not compare to say the "standard catalog of smith wesson." You will not find detailed information on any browning firearm you may be looking for. What you will find is plenty of color photos and the author's opinions on what is collectible or not. The pricing is terrible, the blue book of gun values acknowledges that different features of guns add or detract from value, you will not find that in this book.

The faults of this book can be summed up thusly: there are about 3 pages and as many photos dedicated to the Hi-Power (a firearm that was made for 75 years) whereas a set of 22 firearms that ONE person in the UNIVERSE owns gets 22 pages of text and photos. To summarize: this book has nice pictures but no useful information for a collector.
