

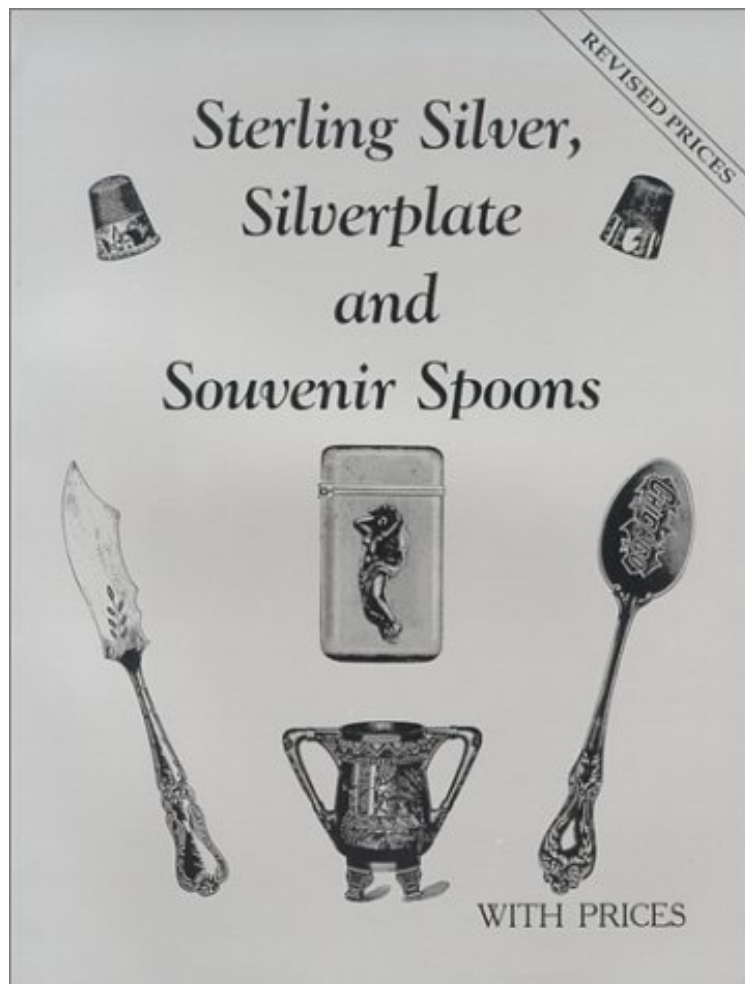

consists of turn of the century catalog reprints. The reprints are sharp and they are interesting to look at but there is not a whole lot of information.

Antique household items made from silver, both sterling and plated, fill these pages in over 1300 engravings from period catalogs. Detailed descriptions include pattern names and numbers, special features, and values lists. Many collectible souvenir spoons are shown along with table items from ash trays to wine coolers.
