

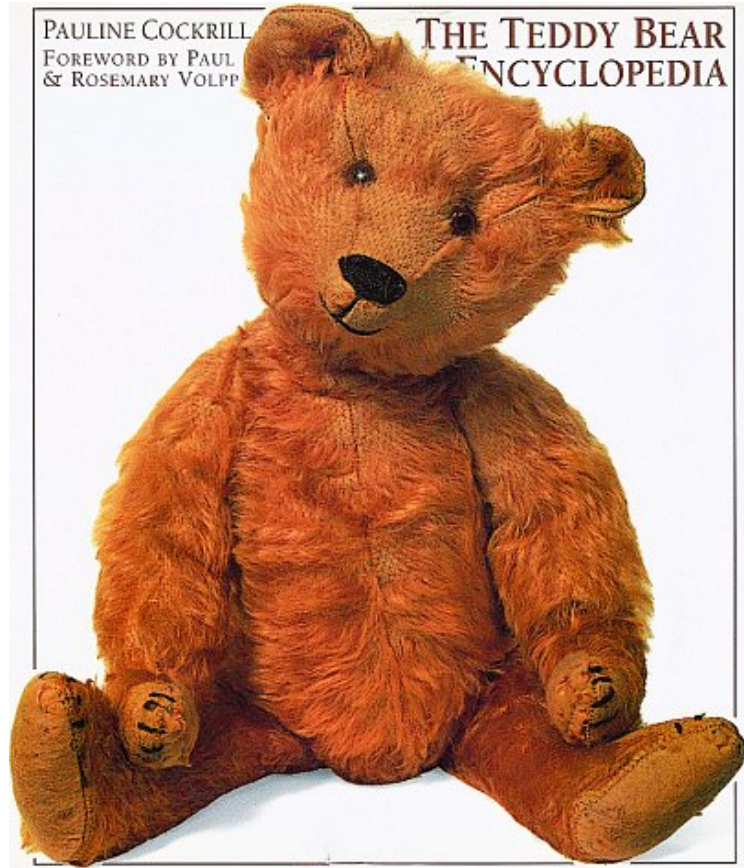

She specialized in the field while curator at the National Museum of Childhood in Bethnal Green, and is a regular contributor to *Teddy Bear Times*. Both DK's *The Ultimate Teddy Bear Book* (1991) and *The Teddy Bear Encyclopedia* (1993) are considered the bibles of arctophily (bear collecting), and are used by collectors, dealers, and toy shops worldwide. Pauline now lives in Alice Springs, Central Australia, where she runs a teddy bear hospital, probably one of the most isolated of its kind in the world.
